

Offer for groups of children (age 13 to 17)

Daugavpils Mark Rothko Art Center offers a special programme for groups of children and youth aged 13 to 17 to discover the Center.

The group visits one of the exhibition rooms of the Art center: the Rothko section (sector A). This programme is an 1,5 hour long (90 minutes). The price per person is 2.50€, with free admission for the group coordinator.

Short description of the programme:

1. Upon arrival at the Mark Rothko Center the group is greeted by a guide who tells them an entertaining story about the place they are visiting (the story depends on the children's age).



2. Visit of the Rothko section. The guide tells the group about the artist's life and his development. In the Rothko section the group can visit the “silence room”, the video room, see original pieces by Rothko, reproductions, and a digital exhibition.



3. In the digital exhibition room, the group can take a picture against the backdrop of the old Dvinsk and send it to their email address. The visit of the Rothko section takes 45 minutes.



4. The group can choose to continue the tour in two ways:

- The group leaves the Center with a guide, who on the ramparts tells them about the Daugavpils Fortress and then proposes a visit to the Cultural Information Center of the Daugavpils Fortress and other places available at that time.
- The group attends a creative workshop about graphic arts, where they get acquainted with contemporary techniques and create their own work of art. They can take their work home with them.
